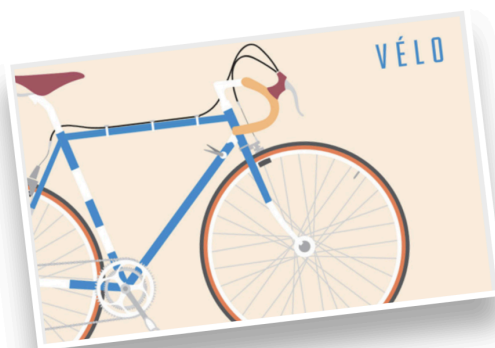

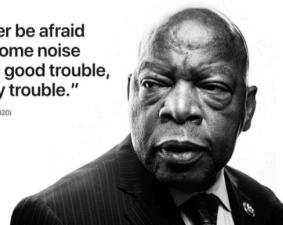
***February is Black History Month and we have two special events planned.***

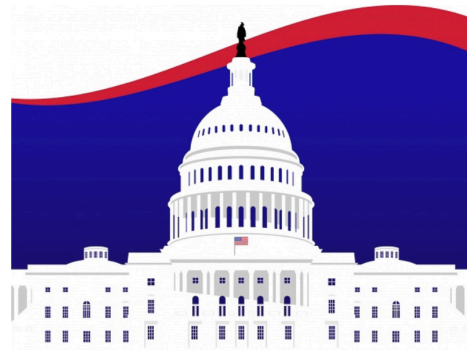
