I'On At Home Covid Policy

In accordance with guidelines issued by the CDC and the County of Charleston, fully vaccinated IAH members can attend events without masking or social distancing unless:

- The event is held at someone's home (indoors or outdoors) and the homeowner prefers that masks be worn and social distancing be practiced.
- The event is held in a public location like a restaurant or museum, and the location requires that masks be worn and social distancing be practiced.

masks and follow social distancing protocols although masks can be removed at outdoor events while seated and socially distanced.

Services will be provided to members who are fully vaccinated and willing to wear masks. Only volunteers who are fully vaccinated and wearing masks will perform services.

Until further notice, every event advertised on our website will include a statement regarding requirements for participation, e.g., masking and social distancing. An individual signing up for an event must comply with these requirements as a condition for attending that event.

All registered participants will be contacted, by the morning of event, regarding location.


