Streaming on Apple TV:

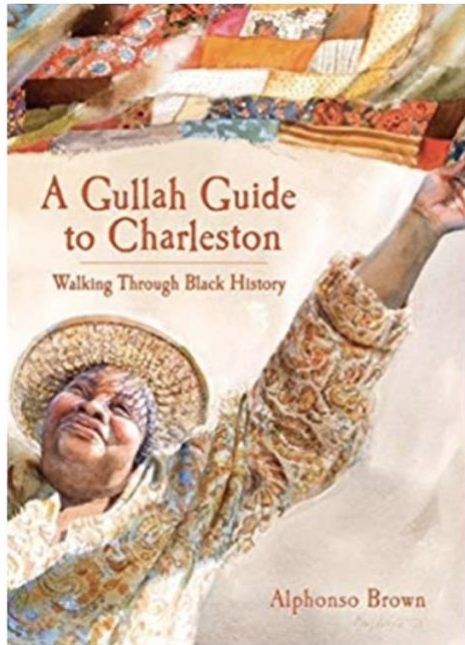
